The Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program is an opportunity for young teachers of English to refine their teaching skills, increase their English language proficiency and extend their knowledge of the cultures and customs of the United States while strengthening the instruction of foreign languages at U.S. colleges and universities.

Fulbright FLTA fellows may teach up to two classes and are required to enroll in at least two courses per semester, one of which must be in U.S. studies. The remaining coursework must relate to their careers in English language teaching. FLTA fellows will also be expected to facilitate cultural events, language clubs and language tables. When return home, FLTA Fellow will have a high proficiency in English and will speak with first-hand knowledge about the United-States, its culture and its people.

Fulbright FLTA Fellows receive a tuition scholarship for their coursework and a monthly stipend to cover living expenses at their host institution. Fellows also receive roundtrip transportation and health insurance coverage. During the academic year, Fellows are also invited to participate in special Fulbright workshops and Fulbright Enrichment Seminars.

Applications must be a Thai teachers of English at Thai universities or public secondary schools; possess the equivalence of a U.S. Bachelor's degree; at least 21 and no more than 35 years old by October 1, 2017; have a TOEFL score of no less than 79 (IBT) or 6.0 (IELTS). They have demonstrated leadership skills, the ability to motivate language learners and an interest in representing their societies in American communities.
